Declaration of Candidate

HAVING DECLARED MY CANDIDACY, I UNDERSTAND THE FOLLOWING:

1. If I am an incumbent elected official or a current state or municipal employee, I have a current Statement of Economic Interests form on file with the Alabama Ethics Commission. However if I am not an incumbent elected official I am responsible for filing with the Democratic Party the Statement of Economic Interests in a timely fashion such that the Party may, as required by state law, file the report with the Alabama Ethics Commission, RSA Union, 100 N. Union St., Suite 104, Montgomery, AL 36104, or P.O. Box 302300, Montgomery, AL 36130-2300, within 5 days of my qualifying. **As a safeguard to insure timely compliance, I am also responsible for filing a duplicate copy of the Statement of Economic Interests directly with the Ethics Commission within the 5 day time period** [Alabama Code Section 36-25-15].
2. I am responsible for filing with the Secretary of State for state offices, State Capitol, Room E-204, Montgomery, AL 36103 or P. O. Box 5616, Montgomery, AL 36103, or the Probate Judge for county offices, **within 5 days**, an Appointment of Principal Campaign Committee form concerning the information of my campaign finance committee.
3. If I am a non-incumbent candidate for a judicial position, I am responsible for filing a copy of my Statement of Economic Interests with the Clerk of the Supreme Court, 300 Dexter Avenue, Montgomery, AL 36104, **within 10 days of qualifying as a candidate** [Canons of Judicial Ethics, Canon 6, Subsection C].
4. The Democratic Party will file a copy of my qualification form with:
 - The Secretary of State or the Probate Judge
 - The Alabama Ethics Commission
 - The Democratic Party Office File
